

# Visitor Policy

Effective July 13, 2021

In an effort to protect our patients, staff, visitors and community, our visitor policy is as follows:

- Visiting hours are 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- All visitors must be 16 years of age or older.
- Visitor must be screened for illness upon entry to the facility to receive a visitor armband.
- Visitor must stay in the room with the patient except for meals in the cafeteria.
- All visitor waiting areas are closed.
- Vendors must be screened and receive a vendor armband.
- Cafeteria and coffee shop patrons must be screened and receive a café armband.

## **COVID-19 Patients**

- No visitors.

## **Non-COVID Admissions**

- Visitors may rotate two at a time during the patient stay.
- One visitor may spend the night with the patient.

## **Birth Center**

- Visitors must be over the age of 16, including siblings.
- Mothers who are in labor may have two visitors with no time restrictions.
- After delivery, visitors may rotate two at a time during regular visiting hours (9 a.m. to 6 p.m.).
- One visitor may spend the night.
- Both parents may visit the NICU at the same time.

## **Emergency Department**

- Patients may have one support person.

## **Pediatric Patients**

- Two immediate family members over the age of 18 may visit, one of whom may spend the night.

## **ICU/CCU and Cardiovascular Surgery Unit**

- Two immediate family members may visit from 10-10:30 a.m., 2-2:30 p.m. and 5-5:30 p.m.

## **Patients at the End of Life**

- Two immediate family members at a time are allowed during a one-hour visitation that is coordinated by a staff member.
- Alternate visiting hours will be allowed if the patient's condition changes.
- Age of visitor may be adjusted if needed.

## **Swing Bed Unit & Tom C. Mayor Rehab Center**

- Visitors may rotate two at a time during the patient stay.

## **Horizons Geri-Psych Center**

- No visitors.

## **Cancer Center, Clinics, GI Lab, Outpatient Services, Cath Lab & Same Day Surgery**

- One support person may accompany the patient.

**Masks are required for patients and visitors at all times.**

## While You Are Visiting

In an effort to decrease the spread of COVID-19, we are continuing to take extra steps to protect our patients, staff, visitors and community.

While you are visiting, we ask you to remember the following:



**Masks are required at all times**



**You must remain in the room unless  
you are visiting the cafeteria  
or leaving the premises**



**If you stay overnight, you are required  
to return to the screening station  
to check-in each day**



**Please use hand sanitizer when  
you enter and exit patient's room**

**When you leave the facility, please check-out at the screening station**
