- Decreased shoulder strength & range of movement
- Pain
- Fatique
- Posture change
- Impaired ability to perform activities

Anderson patients are provided with a comprehensive approach to restore maximum level of function when lymphedema presents. Lymphedema treatment may include:

- Manual lymphatic therapy
- Gradient compression bandaging of the limb
- Fitness programs for flexibility and strength
- Posture and breathing exercises
- Aerobic and conditioning exercises
- Therapy for frozen or weakened shoulder or other muscle imbalances
