Anderson Regional Health System is a not-for-profit health system based in Meridian, Mississippi, that has nearly 100,000 patient visits each year. We offer a full range of inpatient, outpatient and community-based services. Anderson has more than 200 physicians across 35 specialties on its medical staff and employs nearly 1,600 people. Anderson Regional Health System includes Anderson Regional Medical Center, Anderson Regional Medical Center - South, Anderson Regional Cancer Center and Anderson Physician Alliance.

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Access to Health Services

Goal: Improve access to comprehensive, quality health care services.

Injury and Violence

- Continued designation as a Level III Trauma center specializing in treating life-threatening injuries
- On-site helipad for air ambulance service
- Partner with MS Department of Health on car seat safety program
 - MS Department of Health will provide training on car seat safety to Anderson staff members
 - Anderson staff will provide car seat safety classes for the community, as well as assist with proper car seat installation
 - Anderson will offer free car seats/booster seats in conjunction with the MS Department of Health
- Utilize Medical Minutes on TV, our website and Facebook page as educational resources for accident prevention

Maternal, Infant, Child Health

Goal: Improve the health and well-being of women, infants, children and families.

- Continued partnership with local OB-GYNs who provide educational resources to women
- Baby Friendly Initiative
 - Continuing on the pathway to be designated as a center that offers an optimal level of care for infant feeding and mother infant bonding.
- Provide free breastfeeding support through joint affiliation with East MS Baby Café Meridian
- Continue serving as a Mother's Milk Bank depot

Maternal, Infant, Child Health (Continued)

- Offer a full range of childbirth Classes including newborn care, infant CPR and breastfeeding
- Expansion of outpatient pediatric clinic to accommodate more patients and providers
- Expansion of pediatric inpatient capabilities to help families stay close to home for advanced care
- Affiliation with Batson Children's Hospital to bring pediatric specialists to Meridian
- Partner with MS Department of Health on car seat safety program
 - MS Department of Health will provide training on car seat safety to Anderson staff members
 - Anderson staff will provide car seat safety classes for the community, as well as assist with proper car seat installation
 - Anderson will offer free car seats/booster seats in conjunction with the MS Department of Health
- Partner with MS Department of Health to connect moms in need of WIC assistance with information, application, and referral guidance
- Continue offering Baby Café meetings on a biweekly basis as a breastfeeding resource for new moms and pregnant women

Nutrition, Physical Activity and Obesity

- Utilize Anderson Health and Fitness Center's promotional efforts to reach community members in need of an exercise facility, nutritional guidance, etc.
- Host annual road race

- Develop a partnership between Anderson Health and Fitness Center and Meridian Freedom Project
 - Implement a 6-week program for 6th-9th grade students that focuses on the health benefits of fitness and proper nutrition
 - Classes/work outs will be held at Anderson Health and Fitness Center and led by AHFC staff
 - Parents will be included in portions of the program, including a field trip to the grocery store for healthy shopping tips

Reproduction and Sexual Health

Goals Promote healthy sexual behaviors, strengthen community capacity and increase access to quality services to prevent STDs and their complications.

- Provide sexual health education to teenage pediatric patients

Substance Abuse/Tobacco

Goal: Reduce substance abuse to protect the health, safety, and quality of life for all, especially children; reduce illness, disability, and death related to tobacco use and secondhand smoke exposure.

- Offer Tobacco Cessation Classes to the public
- Promote CT Lung Screening for early lung cancer detection
- Utilize Medical Minutes on TV, Facebook posts and our website to provide education about the effects of alcohol, opioid and tobacco use
